## Fee Structure from April 2019

The fees are payable on or before the 1<sup>st</sup> of every month in advance by standing order or by electronic bank payment. Childcare voucher schemes are accepted. Any extra sessions taken in the month will be charged for separately.

A £25.00 penalty fee will be added per week for late fees.

No allowance is given for a child being absent or on holiday.

One months notice, in writing, is required when a child leaves the nursery or one month's fees will be charged in lieu of such notice.

Collection of children after 5.00pm will incur a fee. (Proportional hourly rate applies)

All children are entitled to 15 hours term time of free education the term after their third birthday. Many children can also access, if eligible, 15 hours term time free education, the term after their second birthday. Please ask for details.

These places are offered according to availability. However, we do offer flexibility where we can tailor these hours to best suit parents and use these hours over a longer period. For example, 12 hours all year round, excluding holiday periods and two allocated weeks in the Summer.

Children must attend a minimum of two sessions per week.

Should you require unusual hours or follow a work rota please discuss it with the manager who will try to accommodate your requests.

## **Help with fees**

Some employers give employees vouchers to pay for childcare. These are usually offered in place of part of your salary under a system known as salary sacrifice. Under this scheme both parents can save money. First parent can be up to £243 per month and second parent up to £124 per month. These amounts are exempt from Tax and National Insurance contributions.

## **Briery Kindergarten Fees**

### **6 months – 2 years**

- *Half day:* 8.00 am -12.00pm or 1.00pm – 5.00pm = £26.00
- *Lunch time period:* 12.00pm – 1.00pm = £6.50
- *Full Day:* 8.00am- 5.00pm = £58.50

### **2 Years and over**

- *Half Day:* 8.00am-12.00pm or 1.00pm- 5.00pm = £24.00
- *Lunch time period:* 12.00pm – 1.00pm = £6.00
- *Full Day:* 8.00am – 5.00pm = £54.00

### ***An example of a monthly calculation***

A baby attending 4 half days per week would be £26.00 x 4 = £104.00 per week  
x 4 weeks = £416.00 per month.

Your fees are calculated over a 12 month period to take into account 5 week months and Christmas holidays.

## Uniform

Children are required to wear uniform. Clothing with logo, polo shirt, sweat shirt and cardigans can be purchased at the Kindergarten.
